

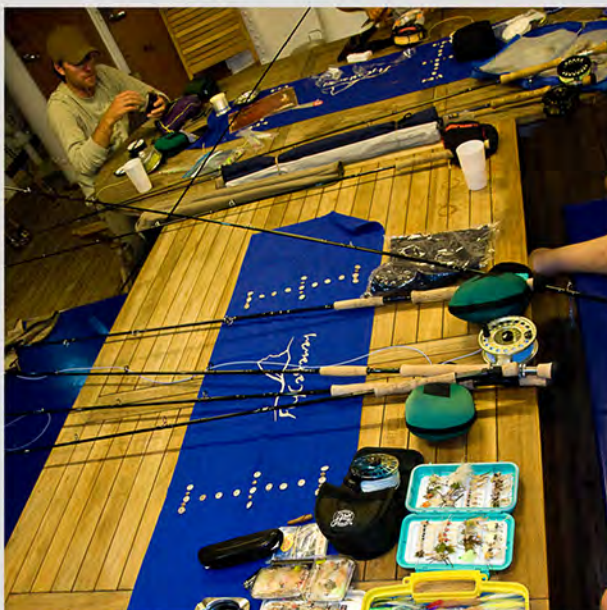
MV Maya's Dugong

the ultimate long range fishing vessel



MV Maya's Dugong is a former research vessel which has been upgraded and modified into a mother ship catering for long range fly fishing expeditions. She accommodates 14 fly anglers, 5 FlyCastaway guides and a crew of 8. The large, spacious and extremely stable vessel is the perfect base from which to explore the remote outer atolls of the

Seychelles. As a fly angler it would be difficult to find a better boat from which to operate. Her ability to store and transport 5 tenders on the spacious aft deck, large size, high fuel storage capacity and ability to cover long distances at good speed and comfort in makes her an ideal long range fly fishing vessel.



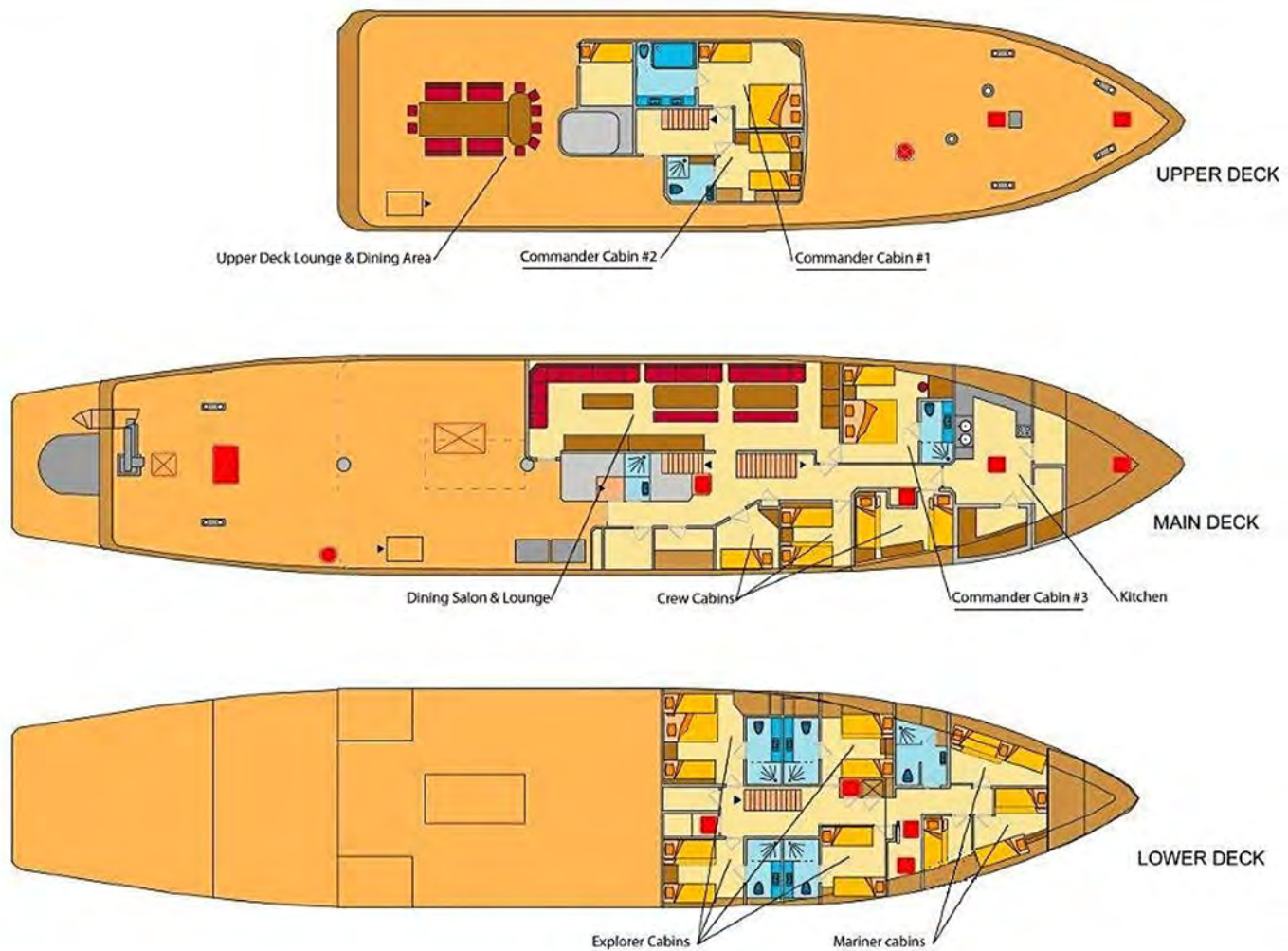
MY Maya's Dugong is a four level vessel, the mid deck is spacious and boasts a large elevated area with a magnificent view of its surroundings. This area is perfect for dining, sundowners and general relaxing. The lower deck's primary function is to store the tender boats and fishing tackle. The stern of the vessel has a set of stairs leading down to a large swimming platform. This feature also allows for a safe and comfortable transfer from the tender boats to the vessel. The vessel features large public areas and facilities allowing for maximum enjoyment of guests' time onboard. A spacious dining salon and lounge hosts guests in air-conditioned comfort for meals and entertainment. The chef prepares a mix of Creole and international cuisine, including regular meals of fresh fish. There is also plenty of open deck space onboard for sun bathing and relaxing, and a spacious bridge and observation deck which allow guests to take in the adventure with a captain's eye view of all the surroundings.

Accommodation & Leisure areas



The MY Maya's Dugong offers 7 spacious guest cabins situated either on the middle, main or lower deck. Each has an ensuite shower and flushing toilet. All cabins and indoor dining or entertainment areas are fully air conditioned, allowing guests a chance to relax in a comfortable environment after a long days fishing out on the flats or offshore. Cabins also feature reading lights and a storage cupboard. The three Commander Cabins are the largest and most comfortable that Maya's Dugong has to offer. Situated on the top two decks of the vessel, these cabins boast en-suite bathrooms with showers as well as windows. Two of the Commander Cabins feature a double-bed plus an extra single bed, while one Commander Cabin offers two single beds in the cabin. The four Explorer Cabins are classic and comfortable, these cabins are situated below the main public-area decks. Complete with en-suite bathrooms with showers, there is one Explorer Cabin offering a double-bed plus a single bed, and three Explorer Cabins with an extra bed and fold-out bunk.
