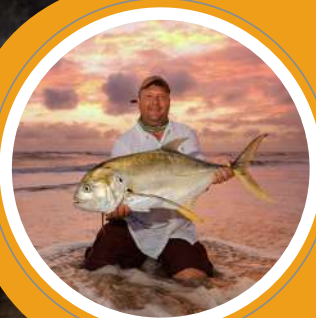

Tarpon

This is one of the only destinations in the world where it is possible to target Tarpon from the shore on spinning gear. Each week presents a handful of opportunities to hook these iconic fish, but landing one takes a test of angler and equipment. In the past we have landed tarpon around the 200 pound mark off the beach.



Jack Trevally

White fin and Crevalle are the two species of jacks available in Gabon. The sheer number and aggressive nature of the jacks, both in the estuary and the mouth, is astounding.



Snapper & Other Species

There are many other iconic species that are plentiful and big in Gabon. Included in this list are Giant African Threadfin, Cuberra Snapper and guinean Barracuda. All of which are capable of growing upwards of 40 Kilos. Snad Sharks, Senegal Kob and tropical garrick all make the occasional appearance as well.

Gabon has the longest stretch of untouched coastline left on the African continent, and along with a massive estuary system rich in nutrients, offers the avid salt water fishermen the opportunity to experience the thrill of targeting the numerous and unique species of West Africa with both spin and fly tackle. The abundance of large and aggressive game fish, all eager to attack a well fished lure, is complimented by Africa's most pristine tropical rain forest which creates the back drop to this one of a kind salt water fishing experience.



Wild Life

This is truly a world class fishery, and also offers the opportunity to experience guided walks through Loanga National park where you will have the chance of seeing Chimpanzees, Lowland Gorillas, Red Riverine Hogs, Forest Sitatunga, Numerous forest Duikers and Monkeys, along with the unique experience of forest elephant and forest buffalo sightings along on the beach. This area is also world famous for its unique birds, with a chance to see Vermiculated fishing owls, Chocolate Back Kingfishers and White Crowned Tiger Herons amongst many others.





CAMP

The camp is on the boundary of the Loango National Park, offering a highly exclusive experience, in which to enjoy both the fishing and wildlife of this untouched venue.

Accommodation is in the form of rustic chalets with twin configuration. This is NOT a five star lodge. Meals are enjoyed on the main living area, which includes a stocked bar and a deck overlooking the estuary.

HOSTED GROUPS

All trips to Sette Cama are under the guidance of a professional host. This adds tremendous value to your experience. With his intimate knowledge of the fishing, and destination, your host will plan each day according to the tides and fish movements. This daily routine will be discussed each preceding evening. This ensures that guests on all trips will know exactly what is to be expected.

Your host will always be on hand to part with local knowledge and advice on the fishing to ensure that you get the most out of your limited time, both on and off the water. Tackle, and more precisely, terminal tackle setup is a vital aspect when targeting the leviathan species of West Africa, and having an experienced hand available to guide you through this is often the difference between the fish of a life time, or heartbreaking tackle failure.



IMPORTANT TRIP INFO



PASSPORTS - All visitors require a valid passport with at least 6 months validity. Visas for a stay of less than 30 days are not necessary for South African passport holders but are required for all other nationals and should be obtained before departure. Tourette Fishing will be on hand to help arrange visa's, and the process is easy and requires little input from the guest.



INOCULATIONS & HEALTH - Valid yellow fever inoculations are required by most countries, please enquire with your local travel clinic. Gabon is a malaria area, please consult your doctor before travelling.



COMMUNICATION - There is sporadic cell phone reception and Wifi is available in camp at a fee.



CURRENCY - Central African CFA Francs - Euro are widely accepted and can be used to settle bar accounts, etc. in camp. The CFA-Euro exchange rate is fixed at 656:1 at time of writing

DAY 1 – Wednesday: Arrive in Libreville – transferred to purpose fitted apartment.

Day 3 - 8 – Friday to Wednesday: In Camp fishing, Sette Cama

DAY 9 - Thursday: boat transfer to Gamba. Private Charter to Libreville

It is strongly advised to use this accomodation option.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

INSURANCE

Comprehensive travel, medical, baggage, money and cancellation insurance are compulsory on all Tourette Fishing tours. This is the clients' own responsibility and should be arranged in your country of origin.

MEDICAL EVACUATION

It is imperative that all clients have adequate travel and medical insurance that includes medical evacuation from point of injury. We strongly recommend you obtain this through Global Rescue - <http://www.globalrescue.com/tourette/> who are world leaders and are strongly linked with the fishing travel industry. You can sign up using the link provided or request the sign up form in PDF format from Tourette Fishing.

CANCELLATION PROCEDURE

Cancellation by Tourette Fishing: In the event of tour being cancelled, the client may choose a full refund or alternatively any other tour that Tourette Fishing is in the position to offer. If the price of the alternative tour is less than the original tour booked. The difference will be refunded to the client. If the alternative tour is more expensive, then the client will be liable for the additional cost.

Cancellation by Client: Notification of cancellation must be in writing and is effective as of the date it is received by Tourette Fishing. Should a person cancel a tour and cannot find a immediate replacement: If Tourette Fishing has more than 180 days notice, deposit is forfeited unless dates can be resold, in which case a 10% admin fee will apply.

If Tourette Fishing has between 179 and 91 days notice, 70% of tour costs are forfeited, unless dates can be resold, in which case a 10% admin fee will apply.

If Tourette Fishing has less than 90days notice 100% of total fare is forfeited unless dates can be resold, in which case 15% admin fee will apply.

Once deposit is received, all revisions are subject to a USD\$100 handling fee.

If you fail to join a tour, or join after departure, or leave prior to its completion, no reimbursement whatsoever will be made.
